



EPIDI FEES

At EPIDI, trading fees are calculated transparently based on the notional value of the position being opened. Applicable fees vary by instrument category and are clearly visible within the EPIDI platform before you place a trade.

Symbol Group	Buy Fee Per \$1000 (Notional \$)	Sell Fee Per \$1000 (Notional \$)
STOCKS US	-0.001	-0.001
DIGITAL ASSETS	-1.500	-1.500
STOCKS EU	-0.001	-0.001
SPOT METALS	-0.024	-0.024
INDICES	-0.024	-0.024
CURERNCY PAIRS	-0.024	-0.024
ENERGIES	-0.024	-0.024

Example:

- Instrument: Gold USDollar | XAUUSD
- Open Price: \$4,500.00
- Open Units: 0.58758 oz
- Buy Fee: \$0.024 per \$1,000 notional

Step 1: Calculate Invested Amount

$$\text{Invested Amount} = \text{Open Price} \times \text{Open Units} = \$4,500 \times 0.58758 = \$2,644.11$$

Step 2: Calculate Commission (only on Opening of the Position)

$$\text{Commission} = (\text{Invested Amount} \times \text{Buy Fee per } \$1,000) / 1000 = (\$2,644.11 \times \$0.024) / 1000 = \$0.0635$$
